

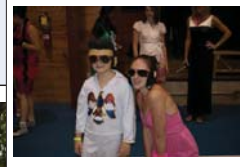

Kate's Club Cabaret raises nearly \$70,000

Demand for KC services at all-time high; "intakes" on record pace

Party-goers shook their booties and rocked our world Aug. 21 during the sixth annual (and best-ever!) Kate's Club Cabaret. Four hundred supporters raised nearly \$70,000 for Kate's Club programs during the fundraiser at W Atlanta Downtown...and the timing couldn't be better!

Kate's Club is experiencing record demand for its services, and is on track to more than double the number of "intakes" (new members) to our programs, compared to 2008.

Fifty-four new children enrolled in our programs through August, thanks in large part to the Clubhouse move to Midtown last year (a more central location, easily accessible by public transportation), and the addition of program director Jana Glass, who is in charge of outreach as well as overseeing the development and implementation of programs for our members.

All Kate's Club programs are completely free to our families.

At the same time that overall intakes climb, Camp Good Mourning enrollment hit a record this year as well, with 71 children attending the three-day camp at Camp Twin Lakes in Rutledge, Ga.

Camp Good Mourning is often cited by our kids as their favorite Kate's Club program and like our continuous year-round programs, provides an opportunity for grieving children to share their experiences, as well as huge smiles and laughs.

Glass, program director for Kate's Club, credited the record intake and Camp numbers to "making outreach a priority at Kate's Club, actively engaging community organizations and developing relationships that serve as referral sources."
